Simon has many years experience teaching, to all levels, art subjects such as Drawing the Figure, Painting in Oils, Watercolour and Gouache, Landscape and Still-Life, History of Art, Photography, History of Photography and The Psychology of Art.

Simon has exhibited his work in major city and regional areas in Australia, Ireland and New Zealand and his work is in collections in the USA, Europe and Australia. He has been chosen as a finalist in notable competitions around Australia such as The Sulman, The Blake, The Duke and The Kilgour. Simon's recent oil paintings involve Japanese Urban Landscapes from drawings and watercolours in situ which reflect a sense of separation from the past as we constantly break into the future.

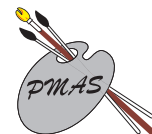

No photography, digital art or sculptures
will be accepted.

CONDITIONS

(No private cameras, phone cameras or video cameras permitted to be used).

- The submitted works must be the original work of the artist and not previously exhibited in the Hastings in the last 2 years. Only the originating artist may submit works. It is their sole responsibility to ensure that works submitted do not infringe any relevant copyright. Artists are responsible for their own insurance.
- Entry fees per work listed in the Diary for each Section. Late entries will not be accepted.**
- All entries must be for sale, suitably framed and ready for hanging. Paintings on stretched canvas do not require additional framing BUT must be ready to hang.
- All works to be securely packed with suitable packing for return consignment. **NO GLASS to be sent through Australia Post. MAXIMUM dimensions for Aust Post parcels is 140cm GIRTH x 105cm length with max weight of 20kg. Australia Post in Port Macquarie will not accept items exceeding these dimensions. If refused by Aust Post, it will be the responsibility of the artist to arrange return of their unsold works.**
- Each work to be clearly marked with artist's name, address, title, section and price, on the reverse side of the painting.
- The Port Macquarie Art Society shall retain 25% commission on sale of all works. Port Macquarie Art Society is not registered for GST.
- Every care shall be exercised but the organisers shall be in no way responsible for any damage, loss or theft.**
- All entries shall be judged but the Port Macquarie Art Society reserves the right to withhold any work considered unsuitable for hanging.
- The decision of the judge shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Merit awards will be given.
- The organisers reserve the right to have any work reproduced in the press, on television, the Society's website or Social Media websites for promotional purposes. Further, the organisers reserve the right to have the winning entry in any section reproduced in full colour, as a magazine illustration. Copyright claims, for these purposes only, will be deemed to be waived by the artist when work is submitted.
- All entry fees and forms should be forwarded to: The Secretary, Port Macquarie Art Society Inc, P.O. Box 529, Port Macquarie NSW 2444. Cheques to be made payable to: The Port Macquarie Art Society Inc and **to arrive no later than Thursday 4 April 2019.**
- All works not personally collected shall be returned as per instructions, or by the most practical means available – freight collect.
- The organisers reserve the right to withhold the awarding of a prize in any one section where, in the opinion of the judge, no work of a suitable standard has been submitted.
- The size of art works submitted for hanging shall not exceed 8 square feet (0.7m²) including frame.**
- An acquisitive prize, where applicable, will constitute the full purchase of the winning entry which will then become the property of the specific prize donor.**
- The following types of Art work cannot be accepted: batik, poker work, bark compositions, plastic relief work, photographs and digital art. Unprotected tempera paintings, wet paintings, china painting, wood painting, tapestry or similar art forms **due to lack of space.**
- PMAS will not accept any works for this exhibition at the Manor House, Hamilton Green, 198 Hastings River Drive, Port Macquarie, outside of the delivery times Tuesday 9 April 9am-11am, Thursday 11 April 9.30am-3.30pm, Sunday 14 April 9am-12pm.**
- Works must be collected from the Manor House on Sunday 28 April 9am-12pm. However, we would like to encourage artists to leave their works as an on going exhibition.**
